ABSTRACT OF VOTES CAST

At an Election held at in Precinct Numbers 2161307003 & 2161307004 in the Town of Lyons in the County of Boulder and State of Colorado on the 3rd day of April in the year of 2018 the following ballot questions received the following number of votes, to wit;

BALLOT QUESTION # 1 A:

SHALL TOWN OF LYONS TAXES BE INCREASED BY \$ \$74,784.00 ANNUALLY (FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR INCREASE) AND BY WHATEVER AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER THROUGH THE ADOPTION OF A TOWN OCCUPATION TAX ON THE SHORT-TERM RENTAL (LESS THAN 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS) OF ANY HOTEL ROOM, MOTEL ROOM, LODGING ROOM, MOTOR HOTEL ROOM, GUEST HOUSE ROOM, BED AND BREAKFAST ROOM, ELIGIBLE CAMPSITE, OR OTHER SIMILAR ACCOMMODATION LOCATED IN THE TOWN IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO DOLLARS (\$2.00) PER DAY EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2019, AND SHALL ALL REVENUES DERIVED FROM SUCH OCCUPATION TAX BE COLLECTED AND SPENT ON ANY LAWFUL MUNICIPAL PURPOSE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE COST OF ACCOUNTING FOR THE IMPACTS OF SHORT-TERM VISITORS TO THE TOWN, WITH SUCH REVENUES TO BE COLLECTED AND SPENT AS A VOTER APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE NOTWITHSTANDING ANY REVENUE OR EXPENDITURE LIMITATIONS CONTAINED IN ARTICLE X SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION?
