  - a) Section 2. Chapter 16, Article 3, Section 210, Subsection (d) is hereby amended as follows (changes italicized and bold):
    - i) Prohibited Uses. Prohibited uses in the CD District shall include those uses that cause excessive air, water, pesticide, or solid waste pollution, create substantial amounts of offensive noise, vibration, smoke, dust, odors, heat, and glare, or is a use that does not otherwise fit the intent and character the CD District. Prohibited uses shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
      - (1) Automobile sales and repair.
      - (2) Gasoline station.
      - (3) Minor or major automotive repair.
      - (4) Mortuary or funeral chapel.
      - (5) Use with a drive-up window.
      - (6) Firearms sales.
      - (7) Firearms manufacturing.
      - (8) Ammunition sales.
      - (9) Ammunition manufacturing.
  - b) Section 3. A new Section 10-10-30 is hereby created in the Lyons Municipal Code concerning a prohibition on the open carrying of firearms as follows:
    - i) Sec. 10-10-30. Unlawful open carry of firearms - penalties.
      - (1) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, it shall be unlawful for any person to openly wear, carry or transport any firearm on or about their person or vehicle.
      - (2) It shall not be an offense under subsection (a) of this section if, at the time of carrying, the person is abiding by all other federal, state and local laws and is:
        - (3) A law enforcement officer;
        - (4) Acting under the authorization of the federal, state, or local government or in aid of lawful authorities when thereto legally summoned;
        - (5) In their own dwelling, place of business, or on property owned or under their control;
        - (6) Transporting the firearm while traveling within a private automobile or other private means of conveyance for hunting or for the lawful

protection of a person or another's person or property, or to or from a place of sale or repair, or from a previous residence to a new residence;

(7) A collector or dealer licensed pursuant to state or federal law and the person is handling or transporting the firearm for lawful exhibition or sale; or

(8) Carrying the firearm for use in lawfully conducted hunting or sporting activity, including, but not limited to shooting matches, target shooting, or trap or skeet shooting.

ii) Upon finding that a person is guilty of a violation under subsection (a) of this section, the Lyons Municipal Court shall:

(1) or a first offense, impose only a fine of up to \$100, and/or other penalty, such as mandatory community service or firearms education, that does not include imprisonment; and

(2) for each and any subsequent violation, shall impose only a fine of up to \$999, and/or other penalty, such as mandatory community service or firearms education, that does not include imprisonment.
