RECOGNIZING AND EXPRESSING APPRECIATION FOR CRYSTAL WHITE

WHEREAS, The Town of Lyons experienced a Federally Declared Disaster in September 2013 that flooded the area; and

WHEREAS, Crystal White has been helping support those who need help in Lyons since the September 2013 flood; and

WHEREAS, Crystal White never shied away from some of the dirtiest, hardest, and most strenuous jobs to help residents clean out their homes after the flood, in all kinds of conditions; and

WHEREAS, Crystal White endured tasks in freezing temperatures, snow, rain, mud, and muck within tight spaces with little air flow in order to clear, haul, dig, and remove anything and everything; and

WHEREAS, Crystal White always helped the flood clean-up efforts with a smile, a reassuring statement to those impacted, and a promise to help until the job was complete; and

WHEREAS, the Lyons Board of Trustees wishes to express its appreciation and acknowledge Crystal White's tireless dedication;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lyons hereby proclaims:

That a new trail along 4th Avenue between the North St. Vrain Pedestrian Bridge to Bohn Park entrance be dedicated in her honor as "Crystal Trail", and
