**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF LYONS, COLORADO DEDICATING THE TRAIL ALONG 4<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE BETWEEN THE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND PROSPECT STREET AS 'CRYSTAL WAY'**

WHEREAS, The Town of Lyons experienced a devastating flood in September 2013 and was declared a Federal Disaster area; and

WHEREAS, Crystal White has been helping support those who need help in Lyons since the September 2013 flood; and

WHEREAS, Crystal White never shied away from some of the dirtiest, hardest and most strenuous jobs to help residents clean out their homes after the flood in all kinds of conditions; and

WHEREAS, Crystal White endured tasks in freezing temperatures, snow, rain, mud and muck within tight spaces with little air flow, in order to clear, haul, dig, and remove anything and everything; and

WHEREAS, Crystal White always helped the flood clean-up efforts with a smile, a reassuring statement to those impacted, and a promise to help until the job was complete; and

WHEREAS, the Lyons Board of Trustees wishes to express its appreciation and acknowledge Crystal White's tireless dedication; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees would like to recognize and express their appreciation to Crystal White for her hard work, effort and dedication to help residents in Lyons with their overall flood cleanup efforts;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LYONS, COLORADO:**

SECTION 1. That a new trail along 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue between the Pedestrian Bridge over the North St Vrain and to Prospect Street shall be dedicated in her honor as 'Crystal Way', and

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of the Town of Lyons shall affix the seal of the Town of Lyons to this resolution.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
