I. REQUEST OR ISSUE:

This resolution approves a contract with Jump Doctors, LLC., a trail and bike park restoration company, for Construction Services for the Lyons Bohn Dirt Jump Bike Park Restoration and Renovation Project.

II. RECOMMENDED ACTION / NEXT STEP:

Approve Resolution 2022-51.

III. FISCAL IMPACTS:

The Town budgeted \$47,000 for this project in the Parks Fund under Capital Projects for 2022. The proposal being recommended is proposed at \$47,620. Staff is recommending that any overage for this project be covered from the Parks Fund under the Building, Maintenance and Grounds or Maintenance and Supplies line items.

IV. BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In May of 2008 Lyons residents and local bike enthusiasts put together and brought forth a proposal for the Town of Lyons to consider the construction of a Dirt Jump Bike Park in Bohn Park for the community to enjoy, promote recreational programming opportunities, and to help support special events, namely the Lyons Outdoor Games. In 2008, a few smaller features were constructed and with additional donated materials, equipment, and volunteer help, additional improvements and amenities were added in 2009 with the use of the attached plans. Other improvements and amenities like the shelter and picnic area, drinking fountain, and adding a yard hydrant have since been made.

Since its inception, the park has been used regularly by local residents and for special events and programming efforts with maintenance being provided by specialty groups

that utilized the park for various purposes in conjunction with the Town of Lyons. In 2013, when Lyons encountered a major flood event, the focus was shifted heavily to flood recovery efforts, and special events and recreational programming declined.

The Lyons Board of Trustees, along with the Lyons Parks and Recreation Commission, and staff have identified the restoration and renovation of the Lyons Bohn Dirt Jump Bike Park as a vital priority for 2022 and beyond. Recent inspections, public comments, and overall maintenance efforts by the Town show that the park is in need of significant repairs and rebuild efforts in order to make it fully functional and rideable again for all user groups.

Staff issued a Request for Proposal on March 29, 2022 (attached-Exhibit B) and has reviewed the proposal received by The Jump Doctors, LLC. (attached with contract-Exhibit A) to design and construct the park per the RFP in order to restore existing features and add enhancements to renovate the park making it more sustainable, improving the overall rider experience, better help with the progression of skills, and making the park flow better to provide for a more exciting user experience.

Work would be planned for a two-to-three-week period during the month of June in order to be open in July.

V. LEGAL ISSUES:

VI. CONFLICTS OR ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES:

The park will need to be closed for a two to three-week period during the month of June. It may be dusty at times but the contractor will be utilizing water to assist.

VII. SUMMARY AND ALTERNATIVES:

The alternative is to not perform the restoration/renovation at this time.
