-Vehicles in/out of town from 5/28/23-6/26/23 = 356,859 – this stat only counts one specific plate/vehicle one time each day per camera during this period. So if a vehicle with plate 123ABC came into town and left town from Broadway on 6/1/23, it would be counted twice. If the same vehicle came in and out of town 5 times on 6/1/23, it would only be counted two times. One time per camera. If the same vehicle came in and out of town on 6/1/23, 6/2/23, and 6/3/23, it would be counted 6 times, 3 times per camera.

- Vehicles in/out of town from 5/28/23-6/26/23 = 148,204- this stat only counts one specific plate/vehicle once per camera during this time frame. So if a vehicle with plate 123ABC came into and left town every day during this period, it would only be counted twice-one time per camera.

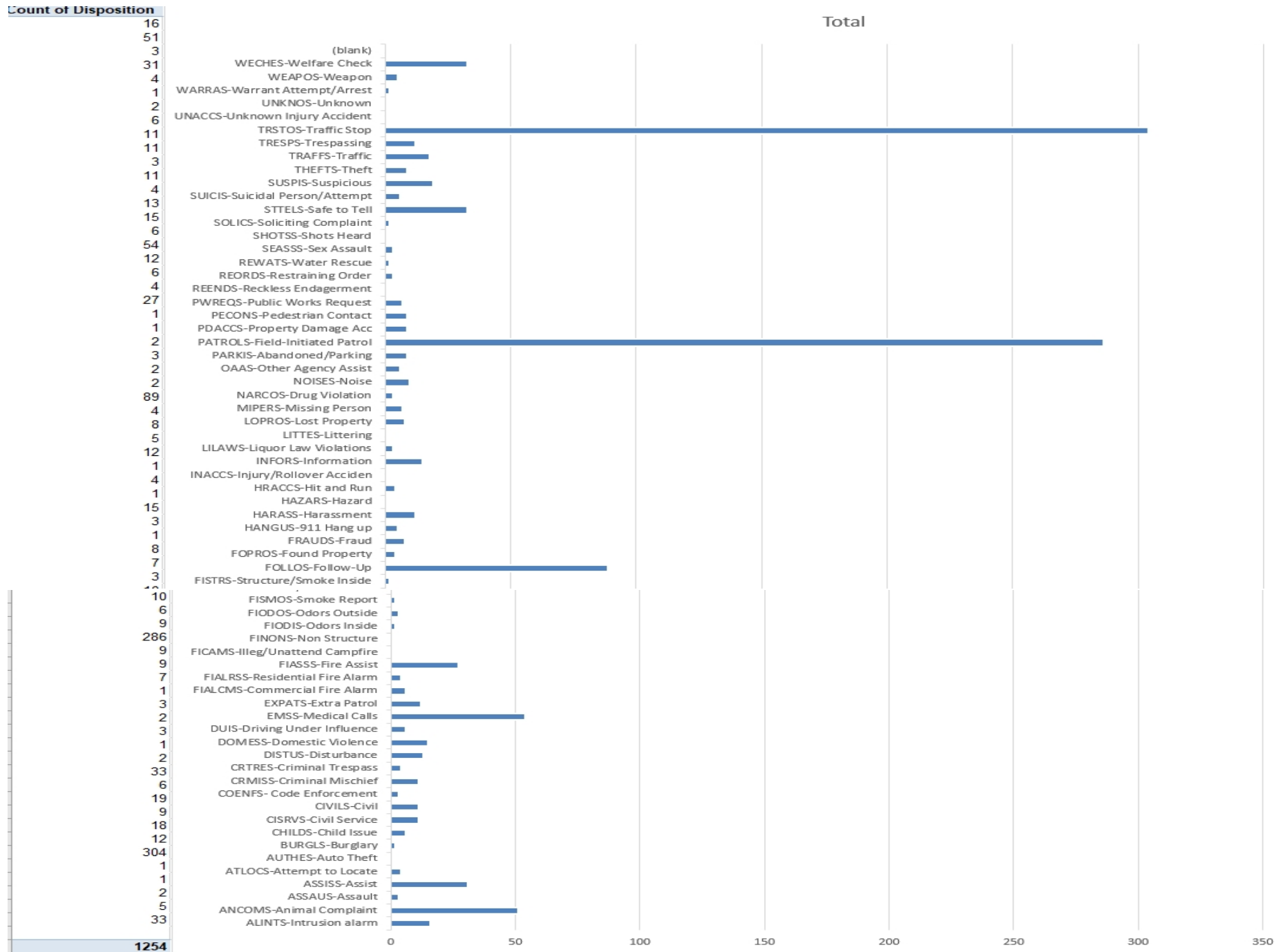

Regarding the high number of sex offender hits, this doesn't mean we have 44 of them in town, or that come and go through town. There is a registered sex offender that lives on Apple Valley, and one at 224 Seward St. Any vehicle that is registered to them or any other sex offender that comes through town will be counted towards these hits.

Regarding the high number of stolen plates, they are either stolen plates on different or stolen vehicles or is the correct plate for the vehicle that passes a camera and that vehicle had their front license plate stolen. The cameras only read the rear plates on vehicles. Most plates that are stolen are the front plates. When pulling stats, Flock doesn't have any info for the vehicles/plates that we get hits on, so I can't see how many of these hits are from the same vehicle without knowing what the plate is. I can run a search of a particular plate and see how many times they come and go from town or are picked up on any other Flock cameras for the last 30 days.
