- I. **REQUEST OR ISSUE:** This resolution awards a construction agreement with CPC Constructors, Inc. for the Salt Storage Building Project. The town staff is recommending a total award of \$108,000.00.
- II. **RECOMMENDED ACTION / NEXT STEP:** Approve Resolution 2023-70
- III. **FISCAL IMPACTS:** The Town has \$96,000 budgeted in the General Fund for this project. The staff has identified 2023 vacancy savings in the General Fund (Streets Department) that can make up the additional \$12,000 needed to complete the project without the need to amend the current budget should the Board of Trustees choose to proceed.
- IV. **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** The Town of Lyons Public Works staff needs a facility to store winter deicing materials that will keep the materials dry and is easily accessible with a front-end loader for loading trucks during a snowstorm. For the past several years, the Town has just tarped the materials, but this is not an adequate system for environmental containment and also poses a workplace injury risk for employees.
