RESOLUTION 2024-44**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF LYONS, COLORADO APPROVING AN
INCREASE IN THE MONTHLY FEE TO PROVIDE ENHANCED
EMERGENCY 9-1-1 TELEPHONE SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Town of Lyons (the "Town") entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement in 1987 to implement an enhanced emergency telephone service through the Boulder Regional Emergency Telephone Service Authority (BRETSA);

WHEREAS, the first BRETSA increase, which was approved by the Town of Lyons Board of Trustees (the "Board of Trustees"), was to \$.50 per line per month in 1993;

WHEREAS, the last BRETSA increase, which was approved by the Board of Trustees, was from \$.50 to \$.75 per line per month beginning in July 2014 to cover support, operating and capital needs;

WHEREAS, BRETSA has determined it necessary to increase the Emergency Telephone Charge by \$.50 per line per month, from the current \$.75 established in 2014 to \$1.25, effective February 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to authorize the increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LYONS, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated by reference.

Section 2. The Town hereby authorizes an increase in the monthly surcharge by the Boulder Regional Emergency Telephone Service Authority (BRETSA) for emergency telephone services from \$.75 to \$1.25 effective February 1, 2025.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
