Hi Aaron,

Attached are the As-Built drawings submitted by the contractor Dohn Construction and their sub-contractors. We have done a cursory field review of the drawings and find them to be substantially complete and in substantial conformance with the construction plans as modified. Subgrade utilities were not staked or verified in the field by our office, other than office review of these drawings. Storm water lines were verified and visually compared to the drawing. The landscaping plan is in excess of the original plan, so we believe that is satisfactory and acceptable.

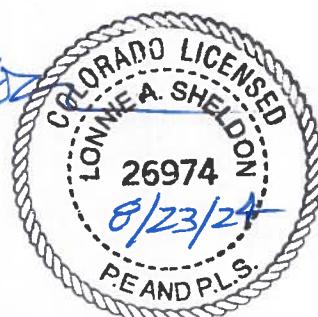
Regarding the improvements in the ROW, all improvements listed on the Estimate Detail have been installed. The trees have been installed to the west of the property with the approval of Igadi since CDOT did not want any of the trees installed in the sight triangles along the ROW. 83 shrubs were listed on the Estimate Detail and it appears 109 were installed in the ROW. We have not verified the type of shrub nor gallon.
