(a) Exterior noise standards.

(1) The following exterior noise standards apply to residential and commercial/industrial zones within the City:

(2) It is unlawful for any person at any location within the City to create any noise, or to allow the creation of any noise, on property owned, leased, occupied or otherwise controlled by such person, when the foregoing causes the noise level, when measured on any other residential or commercial/industrial property, to exceed the following noise levels measured in decibels on a cumulative basis per hour:

(b) Interior noise standards.

(1) The following interior noise standards apply to all residentially zoned parcels and dwelling units within the City:

(2) It is unlawful for any person at any location within the City to create any noise, or to allow the creation of any noise, on property owned, leased, occupied or otherwise controlled by such person when the foregoing causes the noise level, when measured within any other dwelling unit on any residential property, to exceed:

(k) No person shall conduct or permit any activity that produces dB (A) beyond the property line exceeding the level specified in the following table. Where property is used for both residential and commercial purposes, the residential sound levels shall be used only for measurement made on the portion of the property used solely for residential purposes.

The applicable noise levels for (2) and (3) may be adjusted by no more than:

- b. Ten dBA for a total of 10 minutes in any one-hour period; or
- c. Fifteen dBA for a total of one and one-half minutes in any one-hour period.

For purposes of the above table, the following definitions pursuant to WAC 173-60-020 apply:

G. Permissible noise levels.

1. A noise measured or registered as provided in this section from any source other than as provided in this section at a level which is equal to or in excess of the db(A) established for the time period and zones listed in this section, is declared to be excessive and unusually loud and is unlawful.
