I. REQUEST OR ISSUE:

This resolution awards and approves a contract with Dietzler Construction to construct the St. Vrain Trail Extension between McConnell Drive and the junction of Hwy 36/66.

II. RECOMMENDED ACTION / NEXT STEP:

Approve Resolution 2024-89.

III. FISCAL IMPACTS:

Expenses for this contract are eligible for reimbursement through the current funding from DRCOG/CDOT, Congressional Directed Spending, and Boulder County for the St. Vrain Trail Extension Project.

IV. BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This project scope includes a three-quarter-mile trail with three pedestrian bridges crossing three ditches. This multi-modal trail will ensure safe connectivity from the west end of Town to the east, ending at the US36 and Hwy 66 junction. This project is part of an overall regional trail connectivity initiative and will promote safety for all.

The staff is recommending an award to the lowest responsible bidder, Dietzler Construction.
