I understand that you have no control over the fact that I was lied to, but I just want someone to know where I am coming from. This is not what I signed up for.

I moved to this neighborhood purely for the fact that it had no traffic, and no noise except for happy children playing in the streets, which reminded me of my childhood. I thought, how wonderful is it that there are still places on earth where children can play in the streets. I have allergies and cannot be on a busy road. Exhaust makes me ill. When I moved in, my allergies were good. It was a huge selling point for me.

Another selling point: a dark community. The night sky it's amazing in the Rocky Mountain west. I go out every single night and look at the stars, and enjoy the quiet. Before I purchased the home, I came here at night to make sure that there was no light pollution.

With a new subdivision being attached to my neighborhood, I say goodbye to all of the selling points. Not one remains.

It will no longer be quiet. It will no longer have a limited amount of traffic. The exhaust will come through the windows. Children will no longer be able to play in the street. There will be light pollution. What happens to the resident herd of deer? Do they get slaughtered on McConnell Drive? Do the dumpsters in an apartment complex attract more bear? We get to listen to approximately 100 more cars driving back-and-forth?

But what scares me the most is how I was treated by the town after the sewer backed up in my basement. To have children playing and having an innocent time. To live on a road where there was minimal traffic. To be able to look at the night sky and see the stars. That is the home I put my entire life savings into. My first home. And it is being destroyed because of some incredibly shortsighted ideas and no doubt a development company that will lie just like Markel did to me.

I don't know a single human being that would not feel the same way that I do given the circumstances.

I am completely against this development. I don't care if I sound selfish. I put my life into this house. And you're screwing me over. Again.
