


## Parks & Open Space Mission

## Notes

A Conceptual Trail Alignment is a route where the general location has already been identified, usually by a surveyor or trail designer, but not yet built or road. A Conceptual Trail Corridor is a general course that usually links specific destinations, but no landscape feature or specific location has been determined for the trail itself. Corridors are depicted on the map with a dotted symbol in order to portray their inexact location. While a few Conceptual Trail Alignments and Corridors are shown across land that is currently owned by a public land agency, most Conceptual resources are on private land. Conceptual trail designations are merely proposed, no trail has been constructed and the area is not open to public access.




COMPREHENSIVE





# Multiuse Path and Bikeable Shoulders Vision, from Boulder County Transportation Master Plan 2019






**“Heat Map” of


# Lyons Trail Requests




