

MASK ORDER (NEW UPDATE)

After much deliberation, BCPH has decided to allow the mask order to expire and align with the state (BCPH order expires June 10 and the state's on July 1).

This was based on a number of factors, including

- County vaccination and case numbers are better than our neighbors (some significantly better), who have all now stood down their county orders.
- The previous extension of the mask order centered on protection of the health system, which no longer appears to be an issue.
- Any additional protections the order would provide are not enforceable at this point.

Boulder County will provide ongoing “strong recommendations” through communications with the public and our partners.
