5. heARTS of LYONS Update – Melinda
 - a. Sonny sourced some solar lights for a few of the large sculptures, need decision – Chrystal offer her solar light as test for Delilah
 - b. Need to start creating copy for art map (ToL to design and print), **need a project manager for this effort** – Arielle lead, Lauren support
 - b. Zink piece in Bohn Park – ARIELLE ask if we can find and take a rock from new pile in WWTP to use in Bohn Park planter for Imagine
 - c. Move “Elder” to Town Triangle and replace it with wooden (chainsaw) eagle /discussion – STRIKE THAT, we’ll keep where is, too heavy and risky; generally safe location (yet still gets exposure) in the Town Hall plaza.
 - d. My Little Deer by Christine Knapp – possible removal
6. Bell of Renewal Fundraiser Effort (\$1000) – Melinda
Donors of \$250 or more get name engraved in a plaque/visible placement – Bonnie and Lauren to prepare PR material (sub-item e)
Consider doing donor drives in waves with deadlines, e.g. first phase to donate ends July xx.

Topic of 3D printing of a smaller bell (from sculpture) to be cast as a potential fundraiser opportunity... she likes this idea a lot & will be discussing possibilities w/ James.

Last Year-

- *parking situation was better, some peeps complained (let them in free)*
- *Appreciated all volunteer help, they gave a shout out to Arielle!*
- *"Cured"- love to have them again with some sort of revenue from sales going to event*
- * High wind gusts made people nervous- need for emergency preparedness plan for Rain/wind etc.*
- * Tried serious "fine art" side---maybe need to change that*

Ideas for 2019-

- *Need more fun, more people, less serious, more activities, more crafty, more kid stuff*
- * Perhaps a collaboration with Boulder "Firefly" event- Crystal & Charlotte will contact them and have a conversation*
- * Perhaps change art payment and fees related to event:
Perhaps artist would use squares and collect 100% on their sales in exchange for higher booth fee as this would save time and energy for BCAA both on day of event and calculating all funds and writing checks for the weeks after the event*
- *BCAA & LAHC would still get revenue from higher booth fee, parking, and alcohol sales.... they are generating figures to make comparison between charging 60-80 booth fee vs. 30% from artist in past*
