RESOLUTION 2021-11**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF LYONS, COLORADO ACCEPTING PUBLIC
IMPROVEMENTS OF HIGH STREET STORMWATER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Town of Lyons determined to add improvements on High Street, including grading, paving, curb and gutter, sidewalk, storm inlets, manholes, and drainpipe, to convey storm water on the south side of the street away from properties as part of Flood Recovery, known as the High Street Stormwater Improvement Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, expenses for this Construction project are reimbursed by the Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CBDG-DR) administered by the Boulder County Collaborative under the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Town of Lyons and the City of Longmont (INF-00068); and

WHEREAS, all construction work for the project by Roberts Excavation Corporation ("Construction Contractor") is complete and has been inspected by Anderson Consulting Engineers, Inc. ("Design Engineer") and the Public Works Department, and has been found to be acceptable and in accordance with the plans and specifications; and

WHEREAS, a Certificate of Substantial Completion was executed on November 30, 2020 as shown in **Exhibit 1**; and

WHEREAS, the Design Engineer has submitted a Letter of Final Acceptance dated January 8, 2021 as shown in **Exhibit 2**; and

WHEREAS, Staff has received the record drawings from the Contractor, which reflect how the project was built, as well as lien releases for the improvements constructed; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends accepting the High Street Stormwater Improvement Project improvements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LYONS, COLORADO:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated by reference.


Section 2. The Board of Trustees hereby accepts ownership and maintenance of the Public Improvements for the High Street Stormwater Improvement Project.

This letter serves as the Certificate for Final Completion for the Town of Lyons High Street Stormwater Improvements Project, with regard to the Construction Agreement between the Town of Lyons and Roberts Excavation Corporation (the "Contractor"), executed October 14, 2020. Please also refer to the Certificate of Substantial Completion dated November 20, 2020. Based on site visits conducted by ACE staff, and construction management observations provided by JUB Engineers, the Contractor has completed the work in general conformance with the contract documents. As-builts of the construction drawings have been provided by the contractor in accordance with the contract requirements, and the Engineer has prepared Record Drawings dated January 2021. The Work to which this letter applies has been, to the best of my knowledge, inspected by authorized representatives of the Owner, Contractor and Resident Engineer, and the Work is found to be acceptable in accordance with the Contract Documents.

It is our recommendation that the Board of Trustees accept the public infrastructure installed as noted with a warranty period beginning on November 20, 2020, hence expiring at the end of the day on November 20, 2022.
