

## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE:**

On May 19<sup>th</sup> , 2025, at 7 PM there will be a public hearing before the Board of Trustees to consider a new electric rate schedule that will take effect on June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025

Each municipal utility customer shall have the right to appear, personally or through counsel, at such hearing to provide testimony regarding the proposed new schedule.

The new electric rates will not differentiate between Residential & Non-Residential Services, nor have any tiers in service level for the amount of electricity (kilowatt hours, kWh) used.

The new usage rate effective **June 20, 2025**, will be \$0.1339 or 13.39 cents per kWh.

The new base fee will be determined by the type of electric meter required for the service.

For services that use the 2S meter the base will be lowered to \$12 per month. (most customers)

For services that require another form of meter the base fee will be \$24 per month. (Note there are currently only 52 out of 1200 meters that fall in this category, all of which are Non-Residential.)

Customers who qualify for lower utility rates per Lyons Municipal Code Chapter 13 Article 5 Rate Adjustment shall receive a reduction of 20% of the rate schedule.
