2023 RESIDENT PARKING PASS

Parking passes for LaVern Johnson and Bohn Park are available to residents of the Town of Lyons (**utility billing customers only**). One free resident parking pass per household; a second pass may be obtained for \$40. Golf cars are considered vehicles. Non-residents may purchase a season parking pass for a flat rate of \$80 per vehicle. The parking fee for 2023 is currently set at \$2 per hour on weekdays and off-season weekends, and \$3 per hour on peak-season weekends. Parking fees can be paid at the kiosks located throughout the parks. Place the receipt on the windshield. Fees are enforced daily.
