REMAIN BEAR AWARE DURING HYPERPHAGIA

Black bears in Colorado are entering hyperphagia and will spend up to 20 hours a day trying to eat more than 20,000 calories to fatten up for winter.

As bears start to prepare for hibernation and hunt for food, there will likely be increased bear activity in Lyons. Keep your **trash in the garage or secure it until the morning** of your trash pick up. Do not put it out the night before.

Locking up trash and other potential food sources from bears is important to prevent them from becoming reliant on these sources for food. Bears become more of a risk when they associate humans with a food source. Garbage kills bears.



LYONS FLYER BUS SERVICE

Boulder County, in partnership with the Town of Lyons, offers free commuter transit bus service along US 36 between Lyons and Boulder, with 4 routes southbound (to Boulder) and 4 routes northbound (to Lyons). The service branded as the *Lyons Flyer* operates Monday - Friday. Riders can track their bus's arrival time and location in real-time using Transit App, available for iOS and Android. This program provides a rebate of **up to \$500** to county residents, including those who live in the Town of Lyons, who apply and complete wildfire mitigation actions.

STORM DRAINAGE TIPS

Please do not blow or rake leaves into the streets. This can clog street drains, which compromises the Town's stormwater system. Instead, bag leaves or mulch them for compost.

50 YEARS OF CDBG

As part of the 50th anniversary of HUD's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Rocky Mountain Region hosted their event in Lyons on Monday, August 26th with local, state and federal representatives, to commemorate CDBG's role in helping the town to recover and rebuild stronger via their \$19,105,078 in CDBG disaster recovery funding in Lyons. This funding helped Lyons with its recovery and resiliency efforts post-flood.

BOULDER COUNTY INFO

Boulder County has started investigating the feasibility of building wildlife crossing structures on US Highway 36 between Boulder and Lyons, specifically between Lefthand Canyon Drive and State Highway 66.

The boco.org/US36WildlifeCrossings webpage has information on the importance of wildlife crossings, project specifics and a two-question survey. There is also an opportunity to sign up for email updates throughout the project.
