WILDFIRE MITIGATION REBATE PROGRAM

Residents of the Town of Lyons may be eligible for a match of up to \$500 towards wildfire mitigation activities via a rebate. Boulder County will be continuing their program which also offers up to \$500 to homeowners who complete eligible mitigation activities. The Lyons program will utilize the same eligible mitigation activities as Boulder County but will also require an **Individual Home Assessment** which is offered by Wildfire Partners. Please note that Boulder County does NOT require a home assessment to claim a rebate.

PUBLIC SAFETY IN LYONS

Effective this year are changes to the Lyons Municipal Code, including an amendment to the general offenses section, which requires children under the age of 13 to wear a life jacket/personal flotation device (PFD) on the river at all times when in the water through July 15 each year.

The Boulder County Sheriff's Office reminds everyone that with the upcoming Independence Day holiday, to be aware that it is illegal to use any fireworks that leave the ground in the Town of Lyons.

CUL-DE-SACS AND PODS

The Board of Trustees recently approved several amendments to the Lyons Municipal Code. Vehicles parked in cul-de-sacs must be positioned parallel to the curb, with the passenger side wheels along the outside of the curb. It is unlawful for head-in or back-in parking in cul-de-sacs. Portable storage containers (PODs) cannot be parked in the public right of way or on any public street in the Town, so as not to impede traffic flow, obstruct the view of other vehicles or create a hazard.

PARKS AND RECREATION PROGRAMS

In July and August we have a range of youth camps and clinics. Basketball Skills & Scrimmage focus on core basketball skills. Square State Skateboard Lessons run July 28–Aug 1, teaching skate techniques and park riding. Muggle Magic: The Science of Harry Potter camp from Aug 4–8. ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

Beginning this month, a pavement firm will begin mobilization in Lyons with a project list, which includes repaving some streets north of Main Street, installing some curb and gutter, and upgrading storm drainage along various streets in Town. These improvements will enhance safety, drainage, and street quality. Based on the recommendations of the Pavement Management Report, some streets will be repaved, some will have chip seal and some crack seal repairs. Work is expected to last through August.

The contractor will post "no-parking" signage with no-parking dates a couple days before they begin on each street. Your vehicle needs to be off the street during those posted dates. Please adhere to the no-parking signage or your vehicle will be towed! As the work dates for each street get closer, residents on the streets impacted will receive door knockers with the closure dates. Please watch for posted signs and detours.
