# Background

- Transportation Improvement Program
  - Identifies federal and state-funded transportation projects to be implemented in the Denver region
- 2012 - Initial Proposal
  - Unfunded
- 2020 - Revised Proposal
  - Potentially funded
  - Total project cost: \$1,998,000
  - Lyons share: approx. \$400,000 (20%)



# Scope of Proposal

Broadway/US36 (5<sup>th</sup> Ave - 2nd)

- Improve Multimodal Transportation
  - Safety
  - Circulation
  - Parking
  - Transit amenities
- Boost Economic Development Potential
  - Broadway Revitalization
  - Enhance Recreational Access & Tourism

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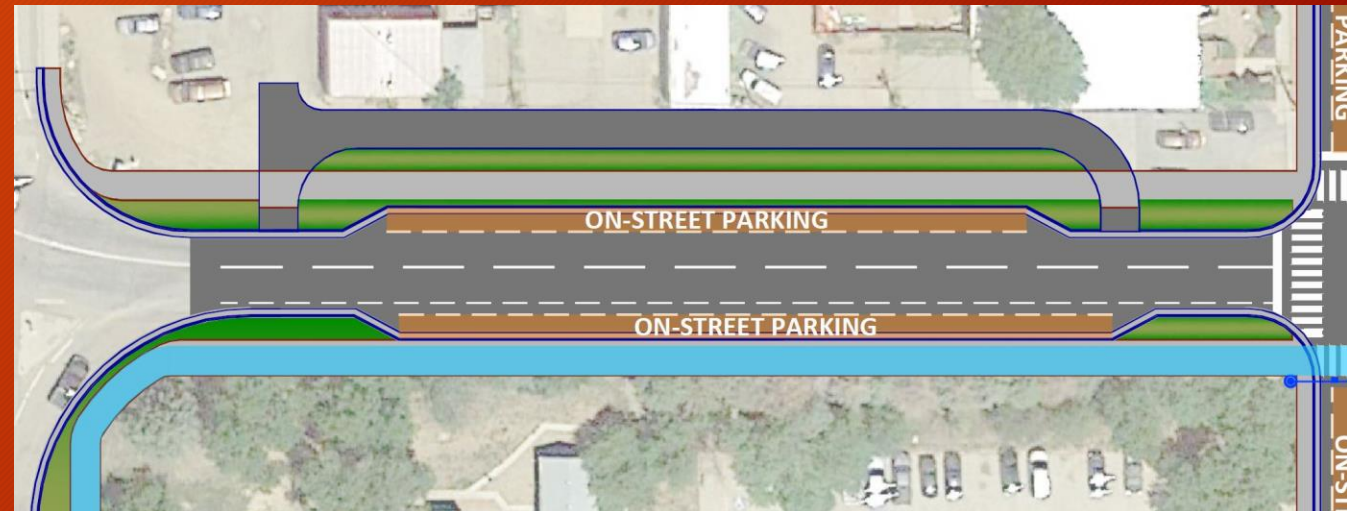
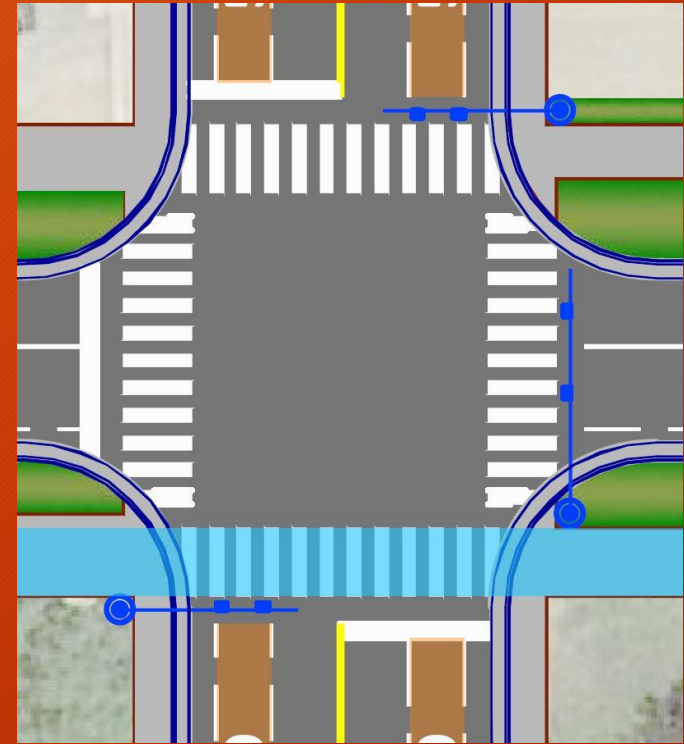

# Improve Multimodal Safety, Circulation and Parking

- Curb Extensions (bulb-outs)
  - Meet ADA
- Narrower Travel Lanes
- New Multi-use Path (hard surface)
- New Sidewalk
- Bicycle & Pedestrian Access to Downtown, Library, Redstone Park and Black Bear Hole
- Adds 51 Street Parking Spaces





# Economic Development Opportunity

- Broadway Revitalization
  - Improve walkability
  - Connects Main Street to Railroad Avenue
  - Offers Return trip tourism
  - Broadens downtown “network”
- Frontage Rd. Beautification
  - Resurface road and improve delivery
  - New sidewalk/on-street parking
  - Activate storefronts
