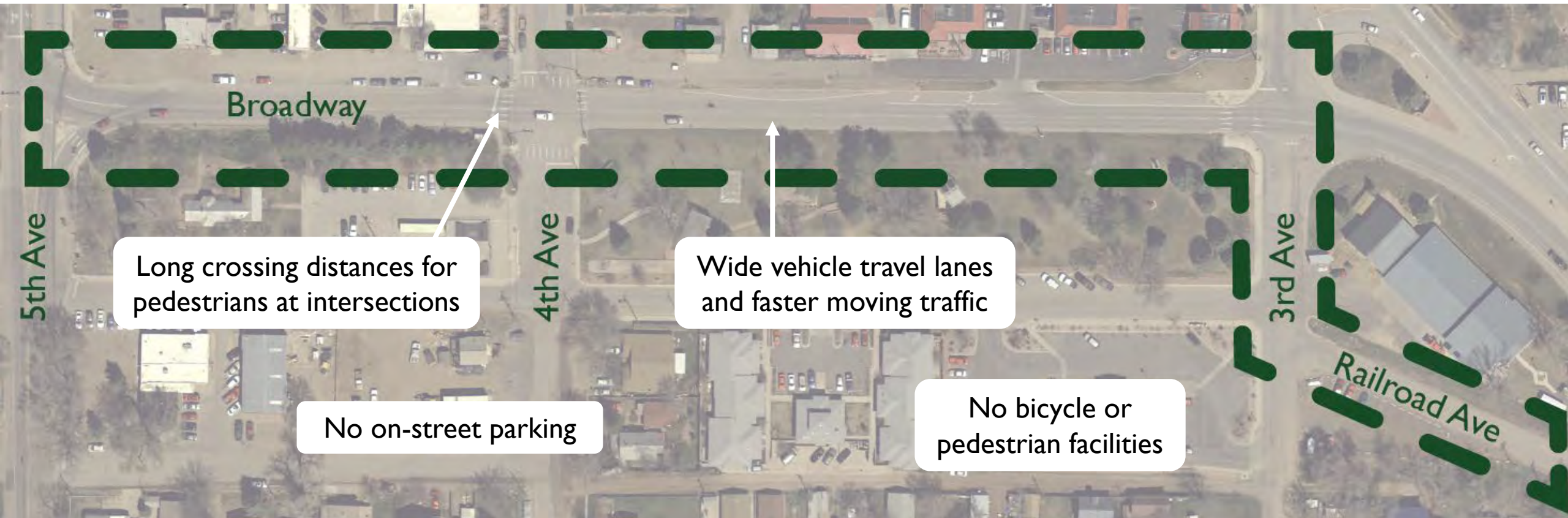

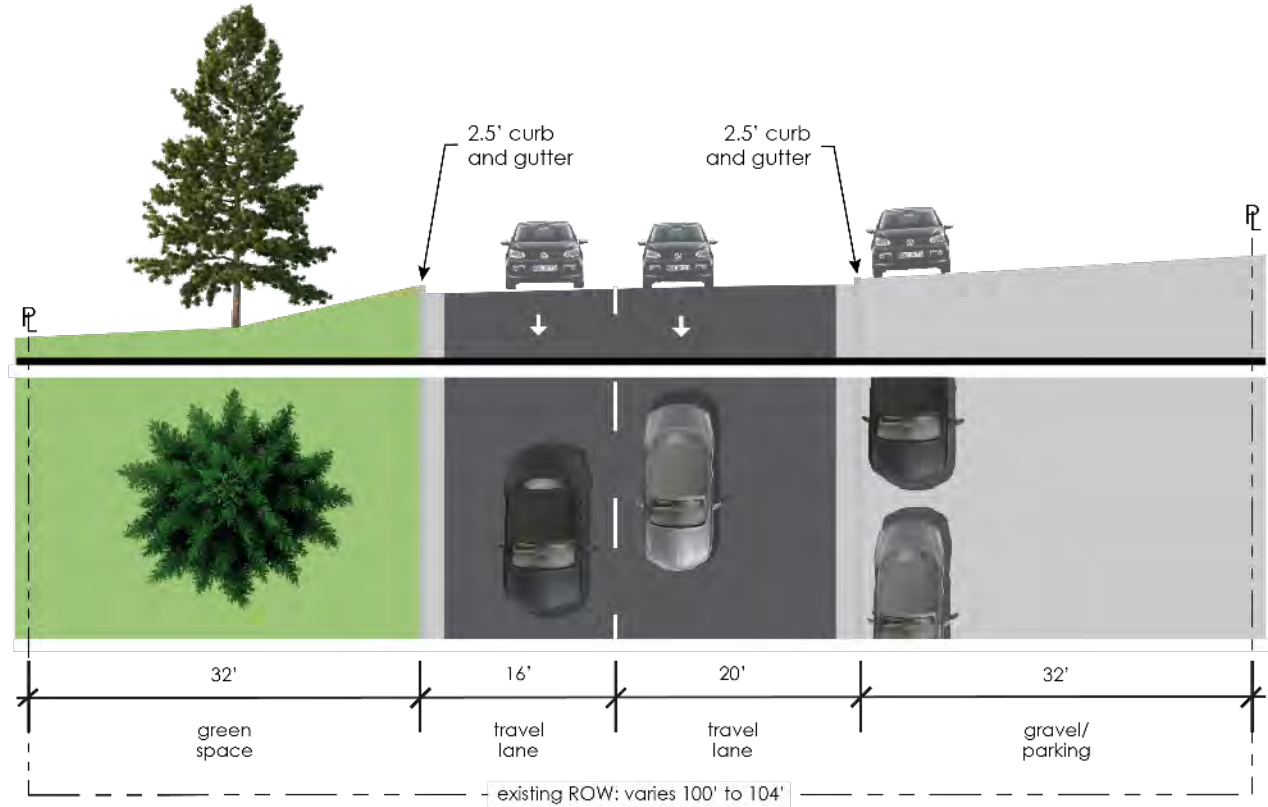

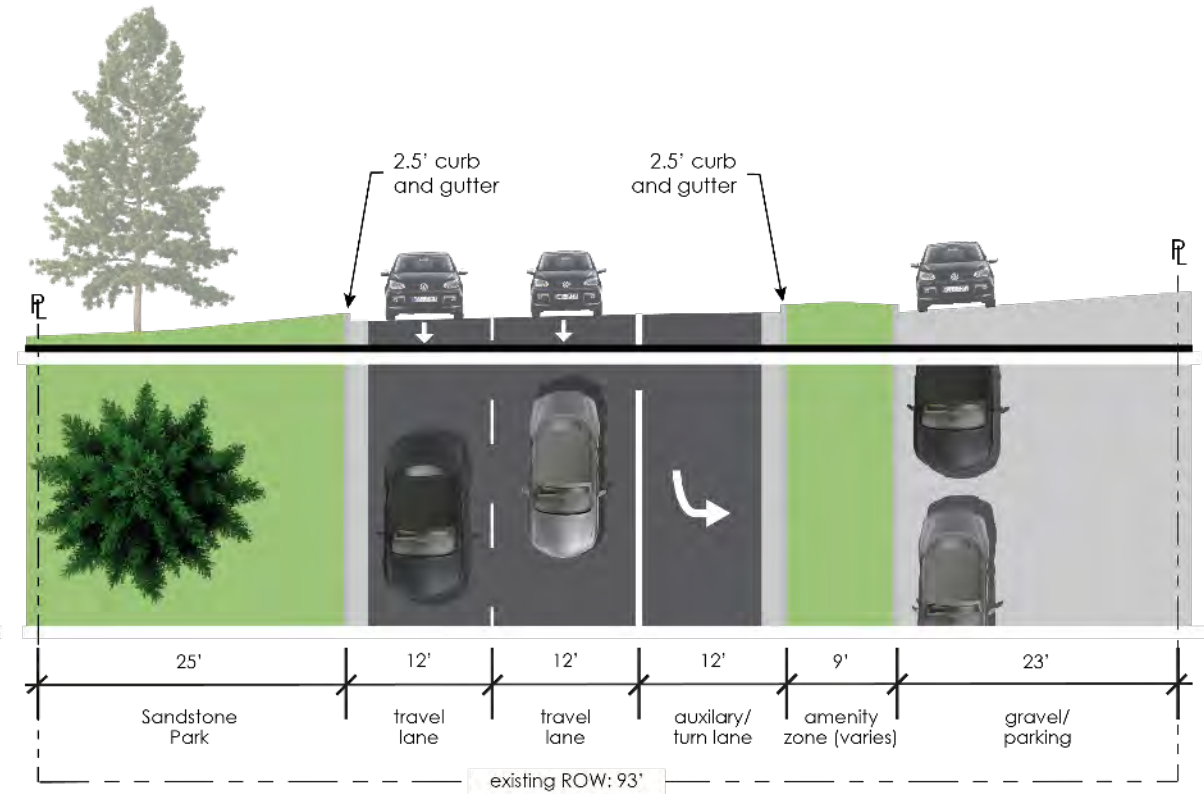

looking west

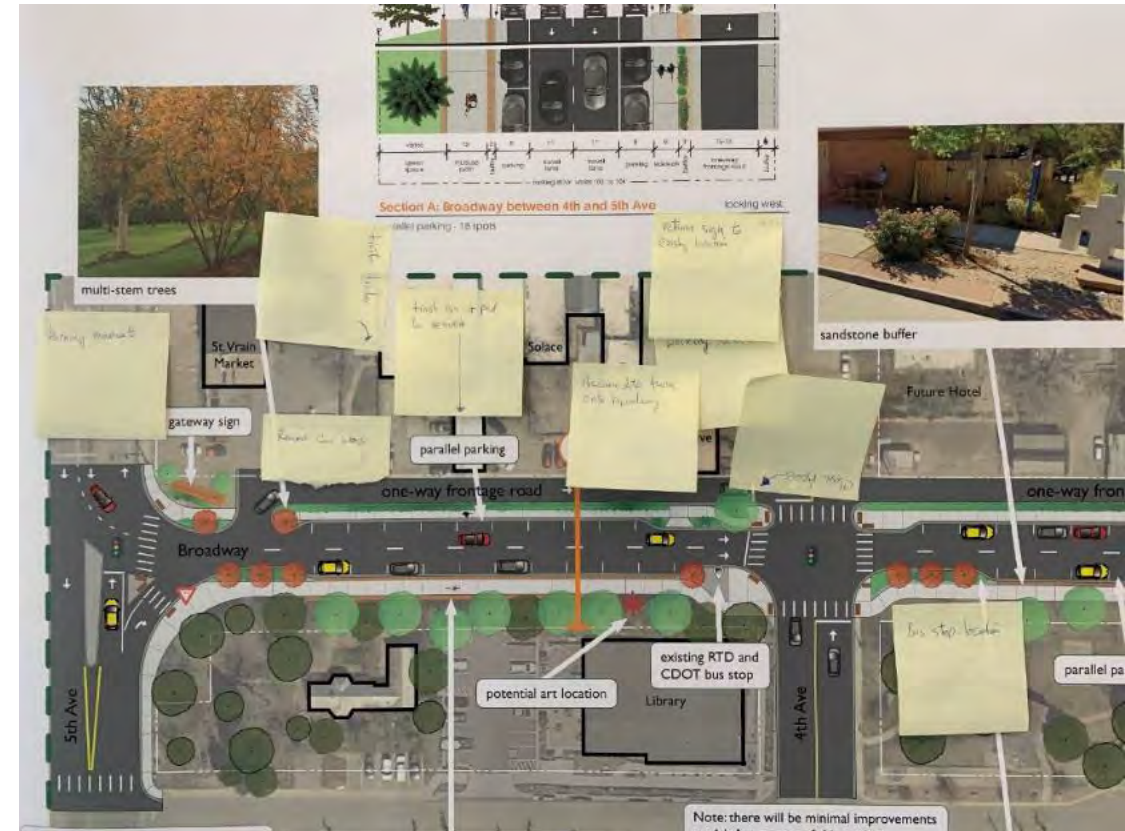


B: Existing Broadway between 3rd and 4th Ave

BUSINESS OUTREACH

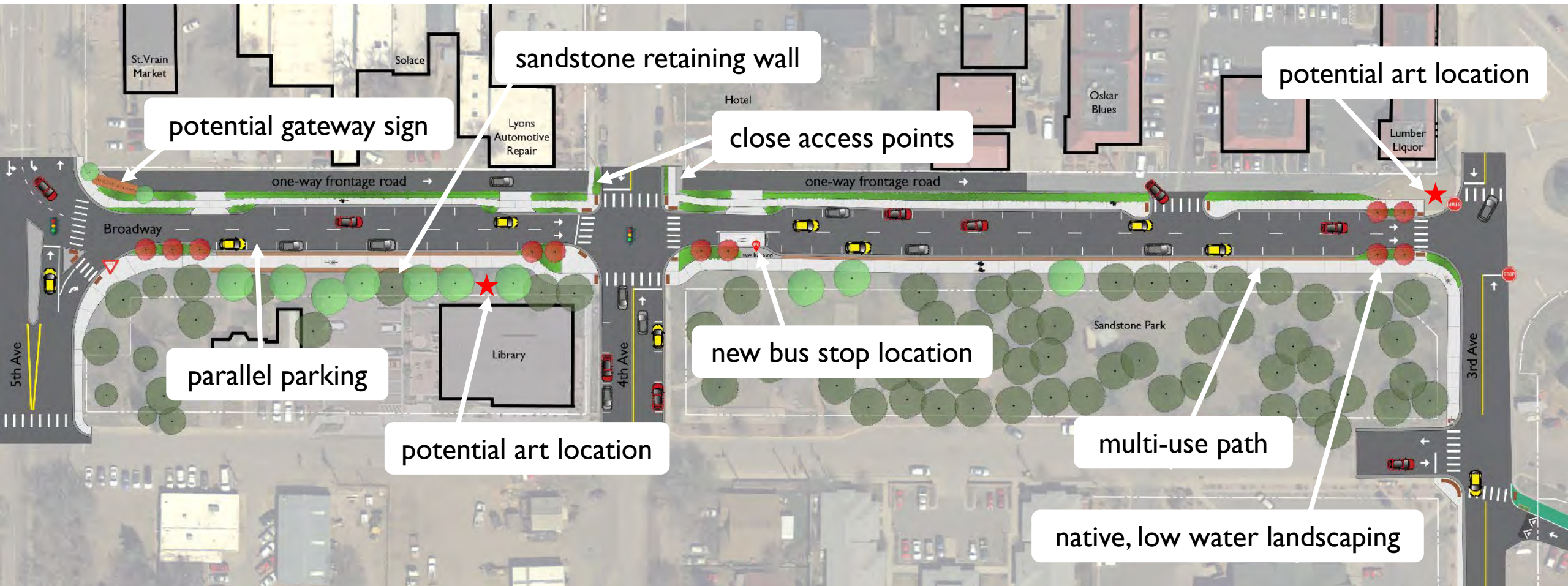
- January 2021: initial open houses
- Mid-March 2022: two open houses focused on design
- Feedback about the proposed concept was recorded and will be considered in the preliminary design
 - Businesses generally liked the design elements that will activate the street (sidewalks, parking, landscaping)
 - Concerns over delivery vehicle access on the frontage road, enough parking spaces, and impacts of the hotel.

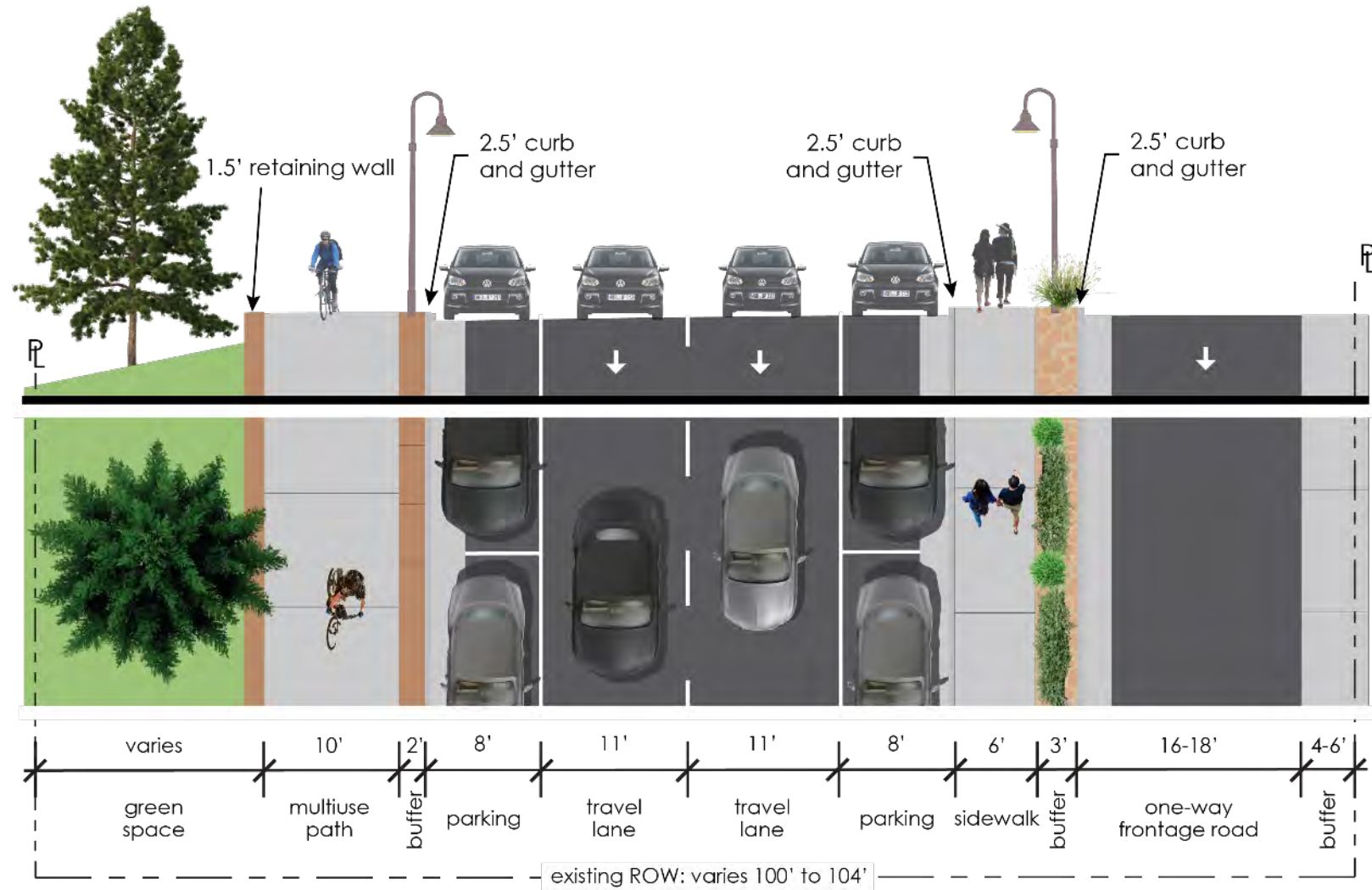


Note: there will be minimal improvements on 5th, 4th, and 3rd Avenues as part of this project.

BROADWAY BETWEEN 4TH AND 5TH AVE

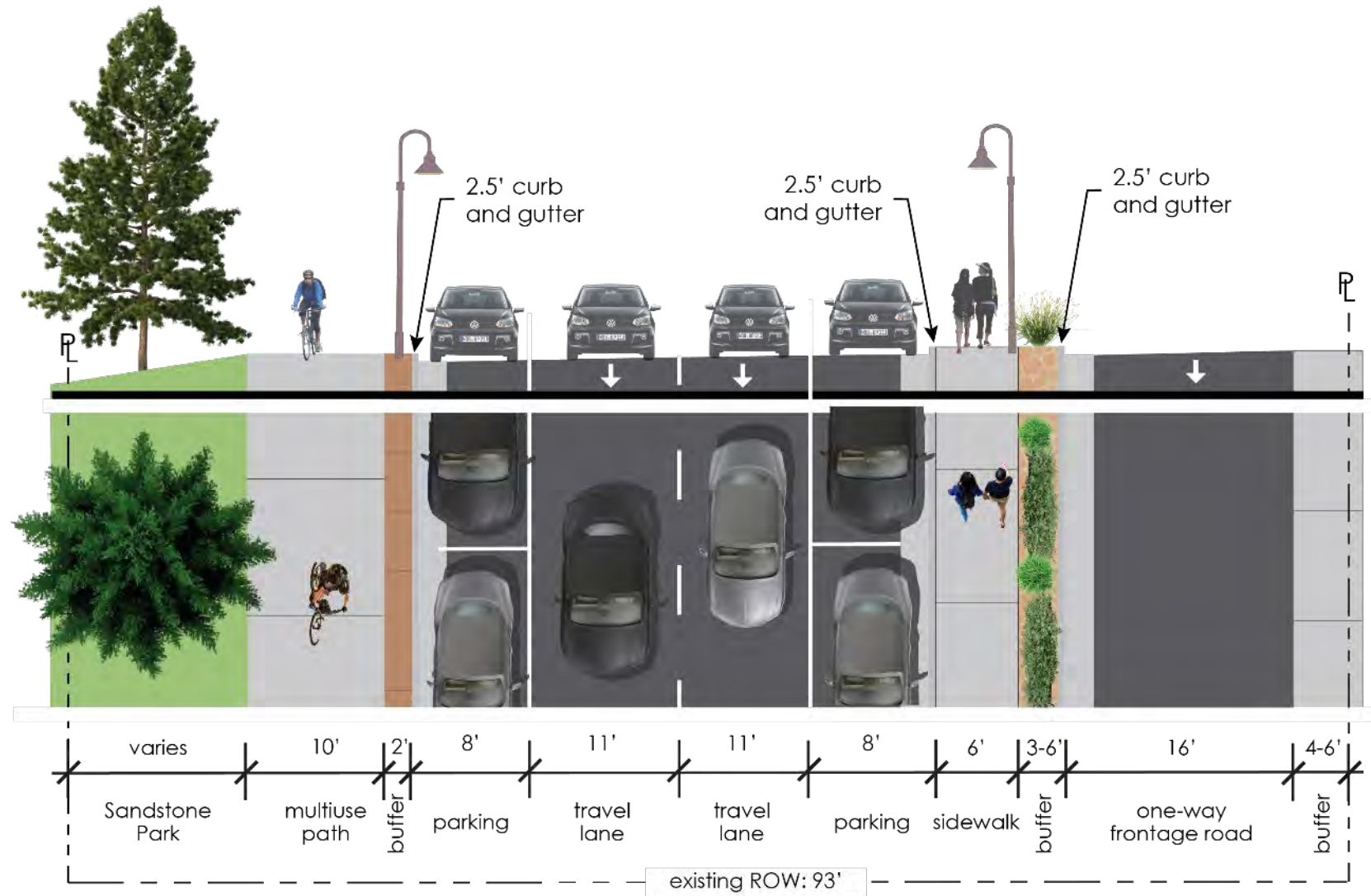

BROADWAY BETWEEN 3RD AND 4TH AVE

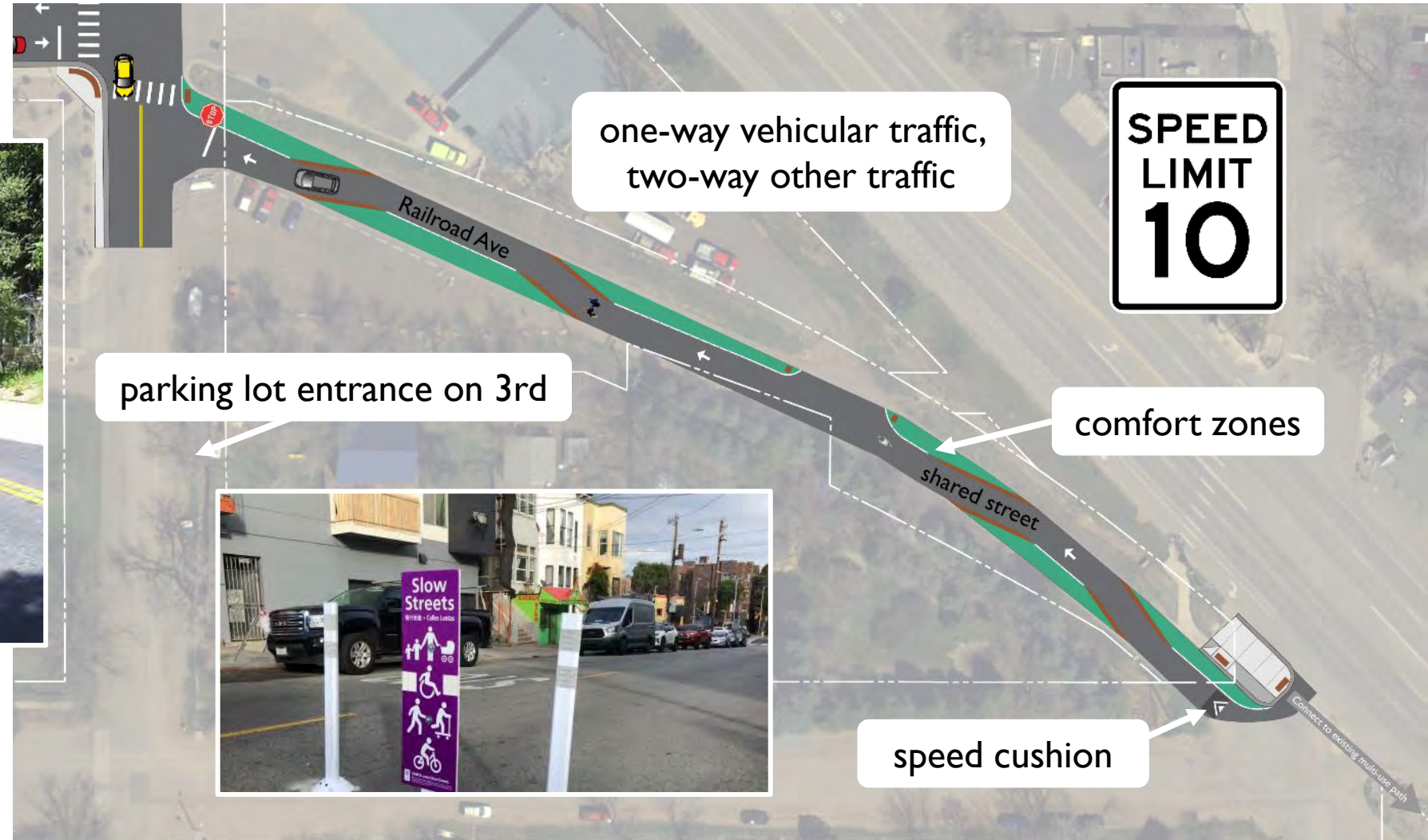

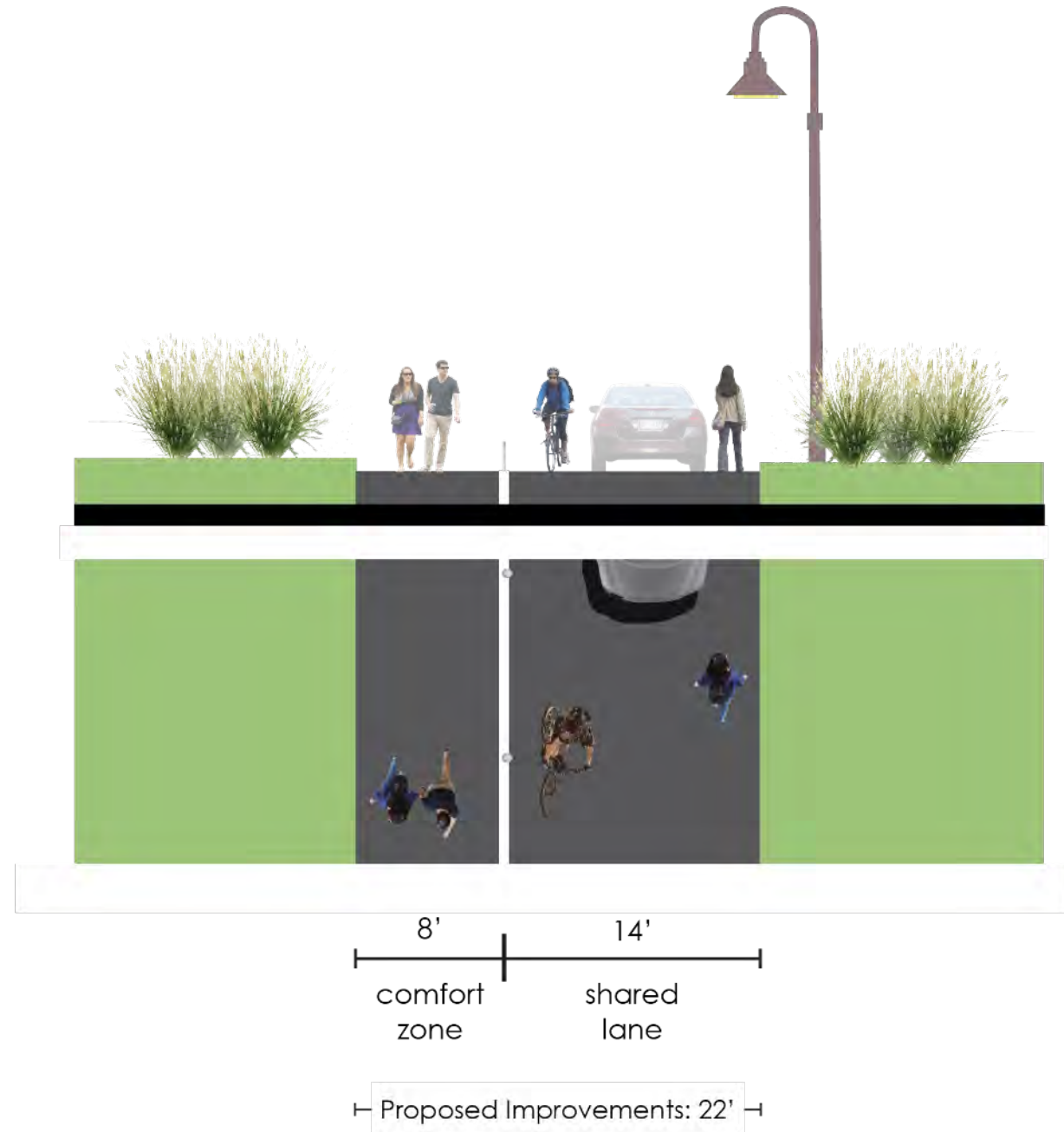
