WORKSHOP ITEMS

The Board of Trustees (BOT) held a workshop at their regularly scheduled September 2, 2025 meeting. The [workshop](#) focused on initial discussion and priorities for the 2026 budget. During the September 15, 2025 meeting, the BOT held a [workshop](#) regarding an update of the Wildfire Urban Interface (WUI) taskforce as well as discussion with Boulder County Sheriff's Office regarding the 2026 budget and contract.



ORDINANCES & PUBLIC HEARINGS

At the [September 2 meeting](#) the BOT heard the 2nd reading of an ordinance of the Town of Lyons, amending the water rights dedication requirements. Two other public hearings were postponed to October 20, 2025, regarding an annexation proposal at 4497 Ute Highway. At the [September 15 meeting](#) the BOT moved an ordinance regarding the classification and use of e-bikes in the town to a second reading.



RESOLUTIONS/CONSENT AGENDA

The BOT approved five items on consent at the September 2 meeting, which included the water rights dedication, accepting a streamflow study and a streetlight study. Both studies are on the Town's website. The September 15 meeting had five items approved on consent, including awarding a construction agreement to Naranjo Civil Constructors for streambank repairs in LaVern M Johnson Park. Work will begin in early October and last approximately four to six weeks.



FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

The BOT approved the [accounts payable](#) of \$393,037.29 at the September 2 meeting. At the September 15 meeting, the BOT approved [\\$648,848.02 in payments](#).



PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

The meeting minutes for the [August 18, 2025 meeting](#) were approved as well as the [September 2, 2025 meeting](#) minutes. There was also a special BOT meeting on September 8, 2025 and those [minutes were approved](#). The minutes for the previous meeting are placed on the following meeting's agenda.



GENERAL DISCUSSION/TOPICS

During general business of the September 2, 2025 meeting, the BOT received an update from the Lyons Arts and Humanities Commission regarding the Android Jones mural on the north side of Town Hall. They also directed staff on items of BOT importance for the 2026 budget, including sending a budget input survey to residents. The BOT also directed staff to bring forth smaller incremental increases regarding utility rates to be in place for the 2026 budget. There was also BOT discussion regarding parades along Main Street related to safety.

General discussion and direction to staff topics during the September 15 meeting included holding off on additional curb and gutter improvements along a short section of sidewalk in front of the LEAF building. In addition the BOT directed staff to continue to work on options regarding the 2026 Boulder County Sheriff's Office budget impacts.

At their [September 15 meeting](#) the BOT discussed the Boulder County Land Use IGA, which had been extended. Following BOT input and discussion, the BOT directed staff to let Boulder County know that the Town of Lyons would be allowing the 2012 IGA to expire on November 28, 2025.



TRUSTEE UPDATES

- Trustee Williams will be the PCDC liaison through April 2026.
- Trustee Browning noted that the EVC shared that Lyons is hosting the Colorado Main St Managers Summit in early October, as well as updates on the wayfinding signage. Also noted that the UEB discussed the 402 Main St referral packet and the annexation referral for property along Ute Highway.
- Mayor Pro Tem Williams recommended a 4-way stop at 4th Ave and Park. Also noted that the HPC did not have a quorum for the September meeting
- Trustee Dady noted that the LAHC had reviewed 26 submissions of the Lyons Municipal flag from 10 local artists. The BOT will review in October. The HHSC reviewed their goals as they relate to the comp plan.
- Mayor Rogin noted that the City of Boulder would be relaxing STR rules during the Sundance Festival. In addition, Mayor Rogin noted that some Trustees would be changing their BOT liaison roles
- Trustee Lowell noted that the EAB has a new, enthusiastic commission. Trustee Lowell is also the new PRC BOT liaison.
- Trustee Hamrick did not attend the SFC meeting
